The affected environment will be maintained in a stable condition that will not be detrimental to the safety and health of humans and animals and that will not pollute the environment or lead to the degradation thereof. **FINAL REHABILITATION:** All infrastructure, equipment, plant, temporary housing and other items used during the prospecting period will be removed from the site (section 44 of the MPRDA) Waste material of any description, including receptacles, scrap, rubble and tyres, will be removed entirely from the prospecting area and disposed of at a recognised landfill facility. It will not be permitted to be buried or burned on the site.
