





Saul put krag uit vrugbare wingerd

"As jy daardie heerlike vet, soet en sappige druiwekorrel in jou mond sit, moenie dink dit word toe-oë in 'n fabriek vervaardig nie," sê Saul Clarke terwyl hy 'n tros swaar en ryp druiwe met sy verweerde hande liefderik

"Nee," verduidelik hy, sy oë glinsterend van trots terwyl hy deur die rye wingerd stap, "elke tros druiwe wat hiér op De Hoop verpak word, word deurgaans sorgvuldig met die hand gekoester – vanaf bloeityd totdat ons dit self verpak en landuit stuur. Dis 'n jarelange proses van toewyding.

Die laatmiddagson gooi lang skaduwees oor die wingerde van De Hoop-plaas in die Paarl. Die druiweparsseisoen het pas begin, en Saul, die wingerdvoorman, is in sy element. Sy gesig straal van vreugde terwyl hy deur die spog- tafeldruifwingerde stap en die vet trosse aanskou wat tussen die blare soos juwele aan

'n kroon hang. "Kyk hier," sê hy opgewonde terwyl hy by 'n spesifieke blok stilstaan. "Môre begin ons span hier pluk. Die suiker is presies

Hy ken elke blok soos die palm van sy hand - elke kultivar en die geskiedenis van elke wingerdstok. Met die presisie van 'n dirigent dui hy aan watter blokke wanneer gepars sal word - eers die Prime Seedless met hul

delikate, soet smaak, dan die Sugranineteen wat so gewild is in die uitvoermark, en met die afsluit van die seisoen sal die manjifieke Red Globe met hul diep kleur en vol geur gepluk word.

Ses en dertig jaar se ondervinding het Saul se kennis van hierdie grond en wingerde so diep soos die wortels self laat groei. In 1989 het hy as algemene werker begin – die mees junior pos op die plaas.

"Ek het als gedoen," onthou hy met 'n glimlag. "Ek het die pakstoor uitgevee, tuine geskoffel en druiwe gepluk. Niks was te min of te veel nie."

Die destydse plaaseienaar, Mike Clift, het Saul se potensiaal raakgesien.

'Jimmy het vir my stapels boeke en tydskrifte oor wingerdboerdery gegee. Saans ná werk het ek myself in dié kennis verdiep. Ek wou als weet – van grondsamestelling tot snoeimetodes; van plaagbeheer tot optimale

Maar Saul se pad was nie sonder struikelblokke nie. Hy praat openhartig dat hy te veel gedrink het. "Totdat ek een dag besef het ek mors nie net geld nie; ek mors my lewe. En hierdie wingerde, hierdie plaas, het te veel potensiaal om dit te laat gebeur."

Met karakteristieke wysheid deel hv sv lewensfilosofie: "Jv gaan nie sukses vind as jy net wag dat iemand dit vir jou gee nie. Die lewe werk nie so nie. Jy moet hard werk, elke dag leer, en elke geleentheid

aangryp asof dit jou laaste een

Hy skud sy kop wanneer hy oor vandag se jongmense praat. "Te veel van hulle wag vir 'n wonderwerk. Hulle wil als hê. maar wil niks gee nie."

De Hoop is meer as net 'n werkplek vir Saul – dis sy hartklop. Hier het hy sy vrou ontmoet en hier het hy sy kinders grootgemaak. Vandag werk sy vrou en twee van sy kinders ook op die plaas getuienis van die Clarke-familie se verbintenis met De Hoop.

Verlede jaar se diagnose van bloedkanker was 'n harde slag, maar selfs dit kon nie Saul se gees breek nie. "Elke oggend as ek wakker word, sien ek uit daarna om tussen my wingerde te loop," sê hy. "Die dokters sê ek moet rus, maar hierdie wingerde gee my krag. Elke druiwekorrel wat ek sien ryp word, herinner my dat die lewe aangaan; dat daar hoop is.'

Hy vat weer aan 'n tros druiwe en sy vingers streel liefderik oor die korrels.

"Ek gaan hierdie siekte wen," sê hy vasbeslote. "Maar eendag, wanneer my tyd kom, wil ek hier op De Hoop my laaste asem uitblaas - tussen hierdie wingerde wat my lewe gevorm

Skoolgeld en klerepryse laat die oë rek Jana Scheepers

Vanjaar se skoolgeld gaan ouers en voogde se beursies behoorlik laat kreun wanneer 'n ekstra 6,3% opgedok moet word om hul kroos op die skoolbanke te

Volgens Statistiek Suid-Afrika (SSA) se nuutste studie het skoolgeld in 2024 met 6,3% gestyg, wat 3,4% hoër is as die land se huidige inflasiesyfer van 2,9%, wat in November 2024 aangekondig is.

Hiérdie styging is ook die hoogste sedert 2020 toe onderwyskoste met 6,3% gestyg het.

Volgens Millicent Merton, 'n woordvoerder van die Wes-Kaapse departement van onderwys, bepaal dié staatsdepartement nie die skoolgeld nie.

"Die jaarlikse skoolgeld word deur skoolbeheerliggame vasgestel en nie die provinsiale onderwysdepartement nie. Skoolgeld verskil van een skool tot 'n ander en word bepaal op 'n jaarlikse begrotingsvergadering waarheen alle ouers genooi word," het Merton gesê.

Op die oomblik beloop staatskole se laerskoolgeld ongeveer R24 400 per jaar, terwyl dié van private laerskole rondom

Vir hoërskoolopvoeding moet ouers onderskeidelik ongeveer R36 000 vir staatskole en R105 000 vir private skole begroot.

In die Paarl, wat van Suid-Afrika se mees gesogte skole huisves, is skoolgelde self nóg hoër.

Hoërskoolgeld in Paarl-Wes kos ongeveer R60 000 per jaar en laerskole R33 000.

Dít is nog voordat 'n enkele sent aan uniforms of skryfbehoeftes bestee is.

Sarah Nicholson van JustMoney.co.za beklemtoon onderwys is ten spyte van die hoë koste steeds een van die belangrikste beleggings in 'n kind se toekoms.

"Deeglike beplanning en slim begrotingsbestuur kan help om die finansiële las te verlig," sê sy.

Skoolgeld is egter nie die enigste prysverhoging waarvoor begroot moet word nie, maar ook skoolkere.

Paarl Post het by vier klerewinkels wat skoolklere verkoop, gaan aanklop om hul pryse te vergelyk.

Volgens PEP se aanlyn winkel sal 'n mandjie bestaande uit twee wit kortmouhemde, 'n trui en kortbroek van enige kleur, twee paar grys sokkies en 'n paar skoolskoene vir 'n laerskoolseun tussen R385 en R430 kos, na gelang van die grootte.

Laerskoolmeisies se ouers sal tussen R421 en R470 opdok vir twee wit kortmouhemde, 'n trui en romp van enige kleur, twee paar wit sokkies en 'n paar skoolskoene.





CapeNature would like to thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Draft Basic Assessment Report. Please note that our comments pertain primarily to impacts on biodiversity and not to the overall desirability of the project.

- 1. According to the South African Vegetation Map (2018), the proposed mining area historically supported Swartland Shale Renosterveld, a Critically Endangered Vegetation Type and a small area of Swartland Alluvium Fynbos, an Endangered Vegetation Type. However, the area appears to be completely transformed by wheat cultivation and no natural vegetation remains except for small, scattered patches across the farm and areas surrounding the Klein Berg River, South-West of the proposed site.
- 2. The proposed site is partially situated within an Ecological Support Area (ESA 2: Restore) which can play an important role in supporting the functioning of Critical Biodiversity Areas (CBAs) and can be vital for delivering ecosystem services. The ESA is mapped due to the presence of a watercourse (non-perennial stream) and where possible, the area should be restored and/or managed to maintain soil and water-related services.
- 3. According to the Department of Water and Sanitation's (DWS) Risk Matrix Assessment, the proposed site falls within quaternary catchment G10F which forms part of the Berg-Olifants Water Management area (WMA). There is one non-perennial stream within 100m of the proposed mining area, however the stream has been highly canalised and modified to accommodate the surrounding agricultural activities. Additionally, there is one perennial River, the Klein Berg River, which is located about 1km away from the mining footprint and we agree with the freshwater specialist that it is unlikely to be impacted by the project. Nevertheless, silt/sediment traps/barriers should be used where there is a danger of topsoil or material stockpiles eroding and entering downstream drainage lines or other sensitive areas. These sediment/silt barriers should be regularly maintained and cleared to ensure effective drainage of the areas and runoff water on exposed areas should be controlled.

- 4. The Terrestrial Biodiversity Impact Assessment confirmed that no areas were found to support indigenous vegetation within the proposed mining footprint and development area and that the threshold for triggering the botanical related NEMA activities is not exceeded.
- 5. We agree with the mitigation measures set out in the Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) to minimize environmental impact and ensure sustainable development. The mitigation measures of high importance are:
 - a. The mining boundaries must be clearly demarcated, and all operations must be contained to the approved mining area. The area outside the mining boundaries must be declared as a no-go area, and areas of indigenous vegetation communities outside of the direct project footprint, if present, should under no circumstances be fragmented or disturbed further.
 - b. Any erosion problems within the mining area as a result of the mining activities observed must be rectified immediately (within 48 hours) and monitored thereafter to ensure that it does not re-occur.
 - c. Mining must be conducted only in accordance with the Best Practice Guideline for small scale mining that relates to storm water management, erosion and sediment control and waste management, developed by the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS). Clean water (e.g. rainwater) must be kept clean and be routed to a natural watercourse by a system separate from the dirty water system. Furthermore, a storm water management plan must apply for the entire life cycle of the mining activity.
- 6. We recommend that removed topsoil is kept separately from other soils and that no stockpiles are placed near any natural areas. Topsoil stockpiles should be protected from any erosion, pollution or contamination, as the soil must be used again for rehabilitation which should be conducted concurrent to mining the mining area should be divided into blocks of no larger than I hectare and only one block should be mined at a time and rehabilitated as soon as excavation begins on the next block. We also suggest that a qualified Environmental Control Officer (ECO) should be appointed to ensure that the mitigation measures set out by the Terrestrial Biodiversity Impact Assessment and Agriculture Impact Assessment are implemented.
- 7. CapeNature does not object to the mining application, provided that adequate avoidance and mitigation measures including rehabilitation will be implemented during the construction and operational phases of the open-cast mine and that the proposed mitigation measures set out in the EMPr are implemented and adhered to.

COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT IN TERMS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS, 2014 (AS AMENDED) AND THE WATER USE LICENCE APPLICATION ("WULA") IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL WATER ACT 36 OF 1998 ASSOCIATED WITH THE MINING PERMIT ON PORTION 2 OF THE FARM BONNE ESPERANCE NO. 83, SARON (DMRE REF: WC 30/5/1/3/2/10352MP; WULA REF: CT31086)

- The email notification of 25 November 2024 regarding the availability of the Draft Basic Assessment Report ("BAR") in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment ("EIA") Regulations, 2014 (as amended) and the water use licence application ("WULA") in terms of the National Water Act, 2008 (Act No. 36 of 1998) ("NWA"), refer.
- 2. Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the Draft BAR and the WULA associated with the mining permit application. Please find consolidated comment from various directorates within the Department on the Draft BAR and Environmental Management Programme ("EMPr") dated November 2024, the Risk Assessment Matrix in support of the WULA, and associated documentation that were available for download from the website of the environmental assessment practitioner ("EAP").

Directorate: Development Facilitation - Ms Adri La Meyer (Email: Adri.LaMeyer@westerncape.gov.za; Tel.: (021) 483 2887):

Comments on the WULA:

- 3. It is noted that a WULA Technical/ Motivation Report was not made available on the EAP's website. In the absence of this document, this Directorate is unable to provide detailed comments on the WULA, as the following information normally included in a WULA Technica/ Motivation Report, is lacking:
- 3.1. Project details.
- 3.2. Location and water use/s being applied for.
- 3.3. Any existing lawful water uses on the property.
- 3.4. WULA process undertaken thus far and registration on e-WULAAS.
- 3.5. Reports and other technical documents requested by the relevant water use licensing authority.
- 3.6. Mitigation measures for water use activity/ies.
- 3.7. Summary of relevant specialist reports.
- 4. The Section 21 (c) and (i) Risk Assessment prepared by Afzelia Environmental Consultants (Pty) Ltd dated 15 November 2024 notes that the WULA relates to water uses identified in terms of section 21 (c) and (i) of the NWA, 1998, as a non-perennial stream is located within 100m of the proposed mining area. It is further indicated that a "non-prioritised wetland" is located within 500m of the site, which is regarded as a small dam system.
- 4.1. Please note that in the absence of ground-truthing of the proposed mining area, the water use licensing authority may regard the Risk Assessment as incomplete.
- 4.2. The Risk Assessment concludes that a "site verification (Wetland assessment) must be undertaken to confirm the desktop findings and risk ratings". Should the relevant water use licensing authority require a site verification, then the Department and other registered interested and affected parties (including organs of state) must be consulted again on the findings of the site verification.
- 4.3. The Risk Assessment was only undertaken for the non-perennial stream. Has it been confirmed by the water use licensing authority that no authorisation is required for development within the regulated area of a watercourse, i.e. 500m radius around the delineated boundary of any wetland?

Comments on the Draft BAR:

- 5. It is recommended that the BAR, specifically the section dealing with hydrology, be updated to include the applicable water uses. Please further be advised that page 85 erroneously indicates that the "proposed project does not require a Water Use Authorisation in terms of Section 39 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No 36 of 1998)". This statement is incongruous with statements made elsewhere in the Draft BAR regarding the need for a water use licence (or general authorisation).
- Should Heritage Western Cape require the undertaking of any heritage-related specialist study based 6. on their review of the Notification of Intent to Develop, such specialist study/ies must be undertaken and released with a Revised Draft BAR for an additional 30-day commenting period.
- Page 168 of the Draft BAR refers to the Financial and Technical Competence Report (Appendix H) 7. regarding the calculation of the financial provision for rehabilitation. Said Report is however only available for the review of the EIA competent authority. Page 168 states that "[T]he annual amount required to manage and rehabilitate the environment was estimated to be R 585 760." It is stated in

Table 28 of the Draft BAR (calculation of closure cost) that "[T]he amount that will be necessary for the rehabilitation of damages caused by the operation, both sudden closures during the normal operation of the project and at final, planned closure gives a sum total of R 206 265,35." If the <u>annual</u> amount is indicated as R585 760, should the planned closure total not be 2-5 x more than the annual amount? Kindly explain the differences in the two amounts.

Directorate: Pollution and Chemicals Management – Mr Gunther Frantz (Email <u>Gunther.Frantz@westerncape.gov.za</u>; Tel.: (021) 483 2975):

8. It is mentioned on page 32 of the Draft BAR that, under very windy/dusty conditions, the applicant/ permit holder might have to substitute alternative dust suppression methods with the spraying of water. In this instance, water would be sourced from an "authorised source" and transported by water truck to moisten the problem area. This Directorate recommends the use of non-potable water for dust suppression activities on internal roads and during mining activities, and the use of potable water must be strictly prohibited. This mitigation measure must be reflected in Table 25 of the Draft BAR related to fugitive dust emission mitigation or written into the EMPr.

Directorate: Waste Management – Ms Sinazo Funda (Email: <u>Sinazo.Funda@westerncape.gov.za</u>; Tel.: (021) 483 2818):

- 9. Page 42 of the Draft BAR states that "[T]he general waste to be generated at the mine will mainly consist of paper, plastic, tin, and/or glass from the office, workshop and processing area." Since the estimated number of workers in addition to the mine manager were not indicated, it is recommended that where possible and appropriate, the applicant provide separate bins for paper, plastics, metals and glass at the source (office, workshop, and processing areas) for recycling purposes. This segregation will facilitate recycling and reduce the volume of waste being landfilled.
- 10. The management of hazardous waste primarily arising from accidental spillages refers. Immediate cleanup within two hours of the spill shows a commitment to swift action to manage and mitigate potential environmental impacts. Further, the containment of contaminated soil in designated hazardous waste containers and its daily removal to a specialized off-site workshop for proper disposal, demonstrates adherence to safe waste management protocols.
- 11. The provision for servicing chemical toilets by a registered contractor ensures that human excrement is managed in a sanitary and environmentally responsible manner. This is critical in preventing and minimizing health risks and potential contamination of ground and surface water resources.

Directorate: Air Quality Management – Mr Etienne Roux (Email: <u>Etienne.Roux@westerncape.gov.za</u>; Tel.: (021) 483 2888):

- 12. Measures to monitor and prevent fugitive dust emissions should be implemented as per the mitigation measures listed on pages 111 and 155 of the Draft BAR and page 187 of the EMPr.
- 13. Operational activities such as mining, crushing, loading of crushed rock, and earthmoving equipment may cause significant noise on-site. The noise mitigation measures should be strictly implemented

during all phases of the proposed mining activities, as per page 112 of the Draft BAR and the

management measures in the EMPr.

14. Page 84 of the Draft BAR states that operations will likely be limited to daylight hours. This

recommendation is supported by this Directorate for implementation and inclusion in the EMPr.

15. The generation of noise on-site must comply with the Western Cape Noise Control Regulations gazetted

in Provincial Notice 200/2013. This must be included in the section dealing with noise handling on page

112 of the BAR and relevant sections of the EMPr.

General comments:

16. Please note that the comments and recommendations do not pre-empt the outcome of the

application. No information provided, views expressed and/or comments made by officials should in

any way be regarded as an indication or confirmation that additional information or documents will not be requested; or of the outcome of the application submitted to the competent authority.

17. The applicant is reminded of its "general duty of care towards the environment" as prescribed in

detailed in the Financial and Technical Competence Report (Appendix H).

The amount of R206,265.35 represents the quantum of the financial provision required to rehabilitate the environment, both for sudden closure during operations and at the planned final closure of the project. This

calculation was done in accordance with the applicable guidelines for financial provision.

Both amounts are based on different regulatory requirements and serve distinct purposes. The Final Basic

Assessment Report will ensure this distinction is clearly articulated.
