Please refer to Appendix F2 for a full copy of the comments.</p> <p>“.....SAHRA issued an interim comment dated 17/01/2022 which requested the submission of the Heritage Impact Assessment inclusive of an Archaeological Impact Assessment (AIA) and a desktop Palaeontological Impact Assessment (PIA). The Final Scoping Report was submitted to the case on the 15/02/2022. An interim comment dated 04/03/2022 was issued which noted the Final Scoping Report and requested the submission of the HIA report and the draft EIA report before further comments could be issued. The draft EIA and the HIA documents were submitted to the case on the 09/06/2022.....No structures, graves or heritage finds of significance were identified during the survey. Effects to subsurface heritage resources can be mitigated by implementing the attached chance find procedure. A PIA was conducted by Prof Marion Bamford and the assessment concluded that it is unlikely that fossils would be preserved in the transported sands of the Quaternary and that the impact on the palaeontological heritage would be low.</p> <p><b>Interim Comment</b></p> <p>The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology, Meteorite (APM) unit notes the HIA and the recommendations provided therein. It is noted that a PIA has been undertaken for the proposed mining, however it has not been attached to the case on SAHRIS.
